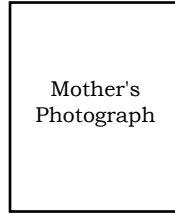
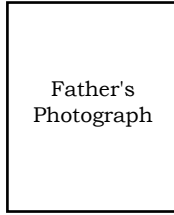
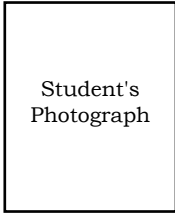

SCHOOL PROFILE

Location

Navy Children School is located within the Naval Complex, Satya Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi 110021.

History

Established on 02 August 1965, it is a leading school in the chain of Navy Children Schools under the aegis of the Navy Education Society. It is administered by a Managing Committee set up in accordance with the Delhi School Education Act, 1973.

Objectives

Navy Children School is a child-centered, co-educational school, dedicated to developing intellectual curiosity and personal growth in each individual through a strong curriculum based on a holistic approach. The school aims at fostering in every student a sense of competence, self confidence, emotional and physical well-being. The school's main objective is to provide education geared to the National Objectives of Access, Equity, Quality and Accountability as envisaged in the National Education Policy 2020. NEP 2020 envisions India-centric education system that contributes directly to transforming our nation sustainably into an equitable and vibrant knowledge society by providing quality education to all.

Recognition and Affiliation

Navy Children School is a co-educational school and has classes from Kindergarten to XII (+2 Grade). The school is recognised by the Directorate of Education, Delhi Administration as a "Recognised Unaided Private School" and is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi for the All India Secondary School Examination (Class X) and the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (Class XII).

Syllabi and Curriculum

For Classes I to V, the syllabus has been laid down by the school, in consonance with the National Curriculum Framework of Elementary Education prepared by NCERT for these classes.

Art Education programmes in the school comprise vocal, instrumental music, dance, drawing, painting, environmental science, astronomy,

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food and nutrition. The curriculum also includes Physical and Health Education programmes and adequate facilities exist for both outdoor and indoor games.

Health and Physical Education Programme

Health and Physical Education Programme is out-sourced and conducted under the guidance of the Sports teachers. It is an assessment, intervention and monitoring programme which promotes physical fitness among all students of classes I-XII. The programme has under its purview sports activities, motor and physical drills, fitness and motor skills assessment.

School Management Software

Mobile App/Parent Portal (Powered by Entab-Campus Care) is a communication tool for parent and school that offers complete online support. Parents can login to the mobile app/parent portal by using individual user name and password provided to them for the following:-

- (a) Student's basic information; entire year's event calendar
- (b) Availability of homework, assignments, time table, projects, attendance, progress report, activity details etc.
- (c) Personal diary for teacher's remarks and parents' feedback.
- (d) Internal messages for parents to communicate with teachers and vice versa.
- (e) Provision for applying leaves online.
- (f) Library history of wards, availability of books etc.
- (g) Get requisition slips, paid fees statements and due fees details
- (h) Online payment of school fees via Credit Card/Debit Card/ Net Banking.
- (i) Notification and SMS reminders for absentees.

How to Install and Access Mobile App?

1. Install the Campus Care app from the Play Store/App Store.
2. Open the app and in the URL bar enter the school URL: xyzcampuscare.in and click on verify.
3. Enter user id and password and log in.

How to Make an Online Payment?

1. Click on the Online Payment menu.
2. Select the due installment and click on the Proceed button.
3. Click on the Pay button. The user will be redirected to the Payment Gateway page.
4. Choose the payment mode: Credit Card/Debit Card/ Net banking.
5. Fill the necessary details. After successful payment, parents will receive the fee receipt as well as a confirmation SMS.

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How to Access/Download Assignments?

Parents can access all recent assignments on the dashboard.

OR

1. Click on the Academic menu.
2. Click on Assignment/Circular.
3. Choose Homework/Activity/Project/Circular/News from the drop-down menu and access/download assignments.

How to Communicate with School?

2. Select the Internal Message option
3. Check the inbox.

2. Select contact's user ID (class teacher/subject teacher)
3. Type the message and attach the file (if any) & press Send.

How to use Bus Route Tracking?

1. Log in to app Campus Care.
2. Go to Route Tracking.
3. There are two options available
 - (a) Route Tracking (By clicking on this icon, the parent can check the arrival time of bus at a particular stop)
 - (b) Live Tracking (Will work only when bus is moving on its route. Parent can track the live location)

House System

The school has an established House System aimed at fostering team spirit and healthy competition among students. The students are divided into four houses-Himgiri, Nilgiri, Udaigiri and Vikrant. Each house is headed by a Captain and a Vice-Captain and a member of the staff acts as the House Warden. All house activities and most school functions are organised by the house Coordinator and assisted by the Associate Coordinator.

The school has an airy, well lit cafeteria. The food is wholesome, hygienic and is served in eco-friendly paper bags. Snacks and lunch items are also sold with prior booking.

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DISCIPLINE AND CONDUCT - STUDENTS

- (1) Navy Children School aims at behavioural elegance and inculcation of discipline in the Students. Every Parent and student are hereby apprised of the consequences for indulging in behaviour which is not permissible in the school.
- (2) **Code of Conduct for Students.** The following acts and conduct on the part of students will amount to misconduct:-
 - (a) Misbehaviour towards a teacher or any other employee of the school.
 - (b) Intentional disturbance of the classes.
 - (c) Continued absence from classes without the permission of the teacher / Principal.
 - (d) Leaving the school premises or playground during school hours without prior permission of the concerned teacher / Principal.
 - (e) Bullying/intimidation of others.
 - (f) Eve-teasing/Adam-teasing misbehaviour towards girls/ boys.
 - (g) Damaging/disfiguring school property.
 - (h) Propagating a strike/disruption of classes.
 - (i) Association with banned organisations.
 - (j) Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher/Principal.
 - (k) Bringing unauthorised people/articles inside the school.
 - (l) Theft/pilferage of school/student property.
 - (m) Involving in acts of moral turpitude.
 - (n) Smoking/Consumption of alcohol/any form of gambling.
 - (o) Use of drugs or intoxicants except on prescription by a registered medical practitioner.

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- (p) Use of violence in any form.
 - (q) Casteism, communication or practice of untouchability.
 - (r) Carrying any kind of weapon in the school premises.
 - (s) Improper use of computer resources of the school; amounting to display or access of unauthorised websites / software portraying indecent pornographic material.
- (3) As per DSAER Act 1973 and NES guide in vogue.
- (4) **Attendance.**
- (a) The minimum requirement of attendance for students in the academic year is 75% for all classes.
 - (b) Leave of absence is given to students on prior application from the parents. In unavoidable circumstances, the absence has to be regularised on the day of re-joining the school with a valid leave note from the parent.
 - (c) All students are expected to attend school within three days of reopening after any vacaton, unless applied for/granted leave for the extended period.
 - (d) Students suffering from any of the communicable diseases must rejoin only with a certificate of fitness, after the due period of quarantine.
 - (e) Absence without leave for more than seven days is liable to result in the name of the student being struck off the rolls. Readmission in such cases entails payment of all dues and fresh admission fees.
- (5) **Use of Unfair Means.** All the students are expected to maintain the highest standard of honesty in academic and in all other aspects of school life. Use of unfair means in tests or homework is considered as a serious offence. When a student is discovered to have used any dishonest means the following course of action will be initiated:-

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- (a) Parent will be notified.
 - (b) The student will be awarded zero mark in the question/paper in which the unfair means were used.
 - (c) For a repeated offence, the student may be expelled from the school or will be liable for such other punishment as may be considered appropriate by the Principal.
 - (d) Where such unfair means/practices have been found in public examinations like XII Board, the rules of punitive actions as promulgated by the respective Board shall apply.
- (6) (a) **Late coming to school.** Late coming to school twice within 30 days period will result in the assignment of one detention unless the student brings a note from parent or guardian. Explaining the reason for coming late.
- (b) **Habitual Latecomer.** Appropriate action to be taken as deemed necessary by the Head of the school.
- (7) **Delegation of Power of Punishment.** Power of punishment may be delegated to teachers for some of first offences to be decided by SMC.
- (8) **Investigation Procedure for Serious Offences.** When circumstances warrant the expulsion or rustication of a student, the following procedure will be followed:-
- (a) The Head of the school will inform Chairman of SMC of the charges.
 - (b) Written notice of charges against the student shall be given to the student and his/her parents.
 - (c) A formal hearing will be scheduled within 7 days of such notice in the presence of a Board consisting of the Chairman's representative, Head of the school and PTA representative.
 - (d) The parents shall be present at the hearing. Witnesses may be cross-examined by the parents.

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- (e) A written record of the hearing shall be kept.
 - (f) The Board shall ascertain the facts and confirm the punishment of expulsion or any other lesser punishment as deemed adequate.
 - (g) The findings and recommendations of the Board shall be sent to the Chairman, SMC for his approval.
 - (h) The Chairman's decision shall be communicated to the parents.
- (9) Whilst three consecutive offences for which penalties have been awarded will render him/her liable for expulsion from the school, the Principal also reserves the right to recommend the withdrawal of a student on disciplinary grounds without warning, if circumstances deem it so.
- (10) The expulsion shall debar a student from being re-admitted to any Navy Children School under NES. No student shall be expelled from the School without giving the parents or guardian of the student a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the proposed action. Expulsion shall be resorted to only in cases of grave offences where the retention of the student in the School is likely to endanger its moral tone of discipline.
- (11) **Disciplinary Action/ Punishment- Primary & Middle-School Children.** The punishments enumerated above do not apply to the primary or middle-school children below the age of 14 years. Every effort is to be made to discipline the Primary School children using variations in tone. In no case is any corporal punishment to be awarded to these children. In some cases of repetitive misdemeanours, the following disciplinary code may be used for Primary and Middle-school Children:-
- (a) To write a few lines if repeatedly late to the school.
 - (b) To detain during break-time or PT period for not doing

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homework.

- (c) Stand in a corner for maximum 5 minutes for talking excessively in class.

12. **Corporal Punishment.** Under no circumstances, the Head of the school/teacher(s) / staff shall resort to corporal punishment amounting to physical assault other than what is stated in Article 11.

Library Rules

1. Students are allowed to borrow only one book at a time against their library card.
2. Library books will be issued for one week at a time. Overnight issue of special books will be permitted only in exceptional cases.
3. Students must be responsible for the books that they borrow. Voluntary damage of library books will be fined.
4. Library cards are non transferable.

Bus Rules

The following rules must be observed in the interest of safety.

1. Students using the school bus must arrive at the specified stop at least 10 minutes before the arrival time of the bus.
2. No student may change his/her bus route without the permission of Bus-in-charge.
3. Students will be held responsible for any damage caused by negligence or vandalism.
4. Unruly behaviour is strictly prohibited. Courteous behaviour is expected at all times.

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SCHOOL LEAVING

1. One calendar month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of such notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.
2. Students who leave the school in May must in all cases pay the fee for the month of June.
3. Transfer/School Leaving Certificates are not issued until the dues of the school are settled.
4. Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:
 - (a) Indiscipline.
 - (b) Unsatisfactory progress in work.
 - (c) Non-payment of school dues of any kind.
 - (d) Detention or repeated detentions in the same class.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FEE PAYMENT

- 1 The school fee can be paid quarterly/monthly/annually as follows:-
 - (a) First Quarter - From 01 April to 15 April
 - (b) Second Quarter - From 01 July to 15 July
 - (c) Third Quarter - From 01 October to 15 October
 - (d) Fourth Quarter - From 01 January to 15 January
 - (e) Monthly - By the 10th of each month.

Note - The fee bill will be issued in advance to children before the commencement of the quarter with details of fee payment.

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2. The fee is to be paid by crossed cheque/demand draft only, drawn in favour of 'Navy Children School.' Date of presentation of cheque in the school will be treated as date of payment. Student's name, class, section and telephone number must be written on the reverse of the cheque/DD. Post dated cheques will not be accepted. Only Local/Multicity cheques will be accepted.
3. The fee is to be paid between 0830-1300hrs, on all working days. Late payment will entail a fine of Rs. 5/- per day from 16th of the fee month till two months, after which the student's name will be struck off the rolls. Readmission will only be at the discretion of the Director/Principal. Readmission fee will also be charged in such cases.
4. Fine for late payment of fee is to be added in the fee cheque itself. Cash payment for fines will not be accepted.
5. In case of a cheque being dishonoured for any reason, the fee will be treated as 'non-paid'. In such cases repayments are to be made in cash only along with a fine of Rs. 200 per cheque. After the end of the fee month the name will be struck off the rolls. The Management reserves the right to initiate legal action.
6. The development fee (yearly) is divided into four equal instalments and will be charged equally on quarterly basis.
7. PTA subscription and Magazine fee are to be paid along with the fee of the first quarter or at the time of admission.

KNOW YOUR SCHOOL

FOR THE ATTENTION OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS

1. Please read and understand the contents of this almanac. Check the almanac regularly for entries about the ward's performance.
2. Parents/Guardian are requested to cooperate with the school in ensuring that their ward follows the rules of conduct and discipline.
3. Parents are requested not to enter classrooms to see their ward or teachers during school hours.
4. Parents attention is drawn to the fact that criticism of the school or teacher in the presence of the ward should be scrupulously avoided because it causes him/her to lose respect for the teachers and consequently he/she fails to learn from them. This also retards the ward's progress.
5. Parents are requested to carry their identity card when visiting the school to attend any function organized by the school or to collect their ward.
6. Navy Children School is a poly bag free zone. Parents are requested not to send or bring any articles like tiffin, stationery, craft items etc. to school in poly bags.
7. Students are not permitted to use fluid for correction in their note-books or during exams.
8. Parents must pick-up their ward within 15 minutes of dispersal time and should drop them only 15 minutes before commencement of school and not earlier.
9. The school will not accept books, tiffin or things needed for the ward during school timings.

KNOW YOUR SCHOOL

10. Parents/Guardians should furnish their latest office and residence addresses along with their telephone numbers to the school. These are vital and in the interest of the safety of their ward.
11. It is requested that the parents/guardians ensure that their ward carries text/exercise books according to the time table of the day.
12. Active involvement of parents/guardians in ensuring that their ward is regular with both academic and co-curricular activities is expected.
13. Parents/Guardians are requested to prohibit their ward from bringing crackers, holi colours, etc., to the school. Bursting of crackers or playing with colours is liable to attract suspension/ expulsion from school.
14. Expensive articles like electronic items, mobiles, radios, video games, jewellery, etc., should not be brought to school. Any violation of this rule will lead to confiscation of the item to begin with.
15. As the medium of instruction in this school is English, conversation in English at home, whenever possible, would greatly benefit the child.
16. Parents/Guardians are to impress upon their ward that any article not belonging to them found in his/her possession by mistake is to be handed over to the respective class teacher/ coordinator/school office immediately.
17. Kindly ensure that the ward comes to school in full school uniform even on his/her birthday and NOT carry anything other than toffees/sweets for distribution.
18. Appointment with doctors, dentists, etc., must not be arranged during school hours.

19. It is requested that basic health education is imparted to the ward to ensure the maintenance of a high standard in personal hygiene.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

1. The uniform is to be worn with pride. Students should come to school neatly dressed in the same. All boys, except Sikh boys, should get their hair trimmed regularly. All girls should tie their hair neatly. Children accompanying their parents for PTM should be in uniform. School uniform should not be worn other than during school hours.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES : WHAT TO DO

DURING AN EARTHQUAKE

1. Keep calm and reassure others.
2. The safest place is open space away from buildings.
3. If you are indoors, take cover under a desk, table, bed, door frame. etc.
4. Stay away from glass doors, glass panes. Walk out calmly.
5. Take children, the aged and the sick out before leaving the building or room.
6. If you are outside stay away from buildings and utility works. Stay in the open till the tremors stop.
7. If you are in a moving vehicle, stop as quickly as possible and stay in the vehicle.
8. Free all pets and domestic animals so that they can run outside.
9. Extinguish all open flames like stoves, candles, lamps and matches.

IN CASE OF A FIRE

1. Do not panic.
2. Raise alarm /Inform the nearest teacher.
3. Switch off fans, lights, air-conditioners and computers etc.
4. Open doors and windows.
5. Do not run. Walk calmly down the stairs in a single file.
6. In case of heavy smoke, wet a towel or handkerchief with water from a water bottle. Then cover your nose and mouth with the wet towel or handkerchief and crawl out towards the nearest exit.
7. Assemble in an earmarked space at a safe distance and wait for instructions.

Note: In case of emergency, follow the exit plan as provided in each room and corridor.

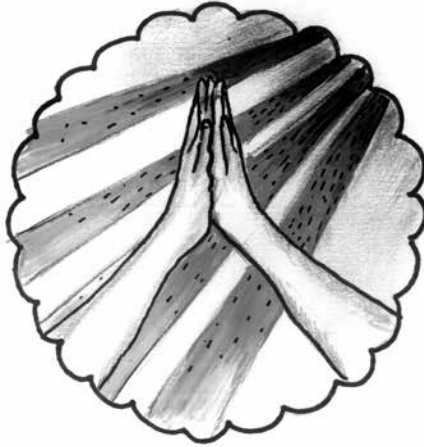

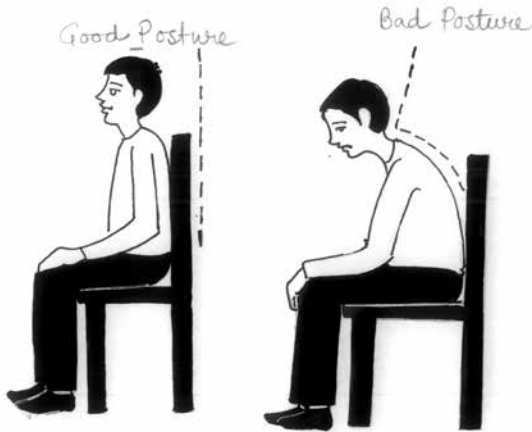

POSTURE

- While you stand, stand straight and tall. Pull your stomach in. Put your weight mostly on the balls of your feet. Your feet should be shoulder width apart. Let your arms hang down naturally at your sides.
- When studying at your desk don't bend forward. Try to keep your back straight with arms and shoulders released.
- Whether sitting, standing or studying don't forget to take breaks! Just walk around or stretch a bit to keep the blood circulation going.

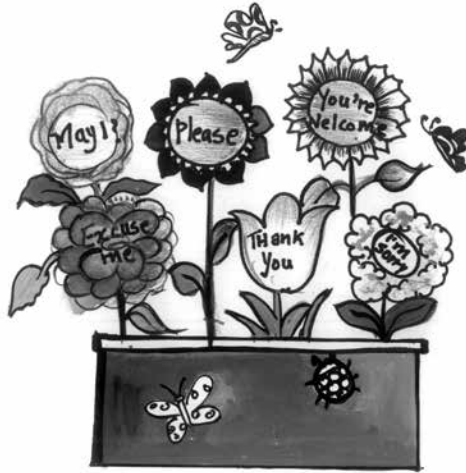

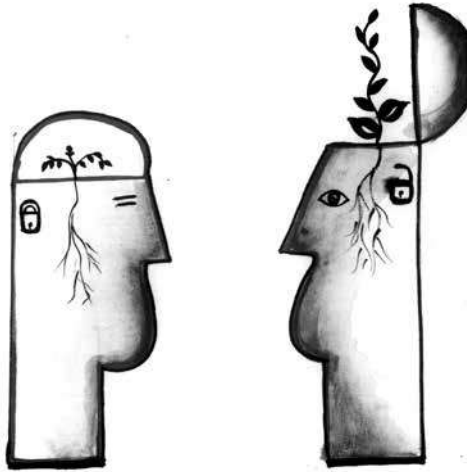
